## Child Psychologist

### Description

Child Psychologist will embrace and incorporate culturally informed practices and relationships with children, families, and communities. Child Psychologist will also emphasize in assessing, diagnosing, and treating behavioral, emotional, and cognitive disorders, while also integrating Indigenous healing practices and traditional knowledge.

### Responsibilities

- Examine and assess behaviour, diagnose behavioural, emotional and cognitive disorders, counsel clients and provide therapy
- Help clients manage physical illness and disorders
- Documentation: Maintain accurate records of assessments, treatment plans, and progress.
- Use standard psychological tests for assessment
- Plan intervention programs and conduct program evaluation
- Apply psychological theory and principles regarding behaviour and mental processes such as learning, language development, memory and perception to develop treatment programs
- Therapy and Counseling: Provide individual, group, and family counseling, and offer therapy.
- Collaboration: Work closely with other professionals, including Mental Health Therapists, and community service providers.

### Qualifications

- A Doctoral or Master's degree in psychology, counseling, or a related field.
- Licensure or certification as a psychologist (where applicable).
- Experience working with First Nations children and families, and knowledge of Indigenous cultural practices.
- Valid drivers license required.
- Must pass a yearly Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check.
